Abbreviation Notes

TiG	Trade in Goods Refer to market access (tariff) liberalization
TiS	Trade in Services. Includes market access for business presence, investment & movement of professional/skilled workers
Investment	Self-explanatory. Usually include investment promotion, cooperation and protection
CCB	Cooperation & Capacity Building. Refer to Indonesia's demand for country partner to support Indonesia's development through various programs, including training and capacity building.
PTA	Preferential Trade Agreement. Trade agreement which covers market access for limited number of goods. Usually only cover less than 50% of Indonesia's total tariff lines.
RCEP	Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership. A compilation and development of ASEAN-China, ASEAN-Japan, ASEAN-Korea, ASEAN-India, & ASEAN-Australia-New Zealand FTAs
SMEs	Small-Medium Enterprises/UKM
SOE	State-owned Enterprises/BUMN
